RULING ON THE RULE TO SHOW CAUSE

IN RE: INFINIUM SOFTWARE INCORPORATED NO. P086501562

A Rule to Show Cause was filed by the State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police ("Division"), alleging that Infinium Software Incorporated ("Infinium") may be in violation of the settlement agreement between it and the Division, requesting the Louisiana Gaming Control Board ("Board") to determine if Infinium is in violation and if so, that the settlement be rescinded and Infinium's non-gaming supplier permit be revoked.

The Board approved the settlement agreement at its January 2004 meeting. The agreement was the result of a Recommendation of Revocation for failure to submit requested information. As part of the settlement, the permittee agreed: to surrender its permit; pay a \$7,500. penalty; and that within fifteen days of settlement approval, Infinium Software, SSA Global Technologies Incorporated, Cerberus Partners, Mike Greenough, Mark Neporent, Seth Plattus, Robert Davenport, Cuy Camerata, Michael Green, Kirk Isaacson, Susan Hickel and John Walles will cease doing business in the gaming industry in Louisiana, and may only resume doing business in the state upon written notification to the Division.

The Division is now alleging that the permittee may have continued to do business in the gaming industry with Hollywood Casino Shreveport, Sam's Town Shreveport, and Casino Rouge, in violation of the terms of the settlement agreement.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT this matter is referred to the Hearing Office for the introduction of evidence pertaining to the alleged violation and a decision on the merits of recession of the settlement agreement and recommendation of revocation of Infinium's non-gaming supplier permit, if appropriate. The decision of the Hearing Officer may be appealed to the Board.
