COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Louisiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Division (hereinafter, the "Division") and Connie Maries Inc. d/b a/ Mama's Fried Chicken (hereinafter, "Licensee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Licensee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by said Notice are set for hearing before the Louisiana

Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office.

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensec are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. The Licensee is a Type 2 licensed establishment located at 2307 Jake Drive Opelousas, Louisiana, 70570.
- 2. On July 31, 2021, Paul Bellard ("Mr. Bellard"), the 100% owner of the Licensee, passed away. As a result of his death, Mr. Bellard's ownership interest in the Licensee transferred equally to his four children: Connie B. Stelly, Arlene B. Fisher, Paul T. Bellard, and Ted D. Bellard.
 - 3. On June 27, 2022, the Licensee notified the Division of Mr. Bellard's death.
- 4. On July 5, 2023, the Division received an Annual Licensee Form and supporting documents for the 2023-2024 renewal period. Upon review of the supporting documents, the Division discovered that the Alcoholic Beverage Permit ("ATC permit") submitted by the Licensee as part of the 2023-2024 renewal documents expired on July 31, 2021.
- 5. On July 11, 2023, Connie B. Stelly, through a Sale of Share Holders Interest, purchased her three siblings ownership interest in the Licensee.
- 6. On August 17, 2023, the Licensee submitted documentation to the Division indicating that it had obtained a new and valid ATC permit on August 7, 2023.
- 7. The Licensee failed to notify the Division within 10 calendar days of Mr. Bellard's death, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(13) and LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).
- 8. The Licensee failed to maintain a valid ATC permit and continued to operate video draw poker devices from August 1, 2021 through July 6, 2023, in violation of La. R.S. 27:413(A).

9. The Licensee failed to notify the Division of the transfer of ownership interest to Connie B. Stelly from Arlene B. Fisher, Paul T. Bellard, and Ted D. Bellard within 10 calendar days of its occurrence, in violation of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(13) and LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of administrative action, Licensee will pay a penalty of FOURTEEN THOUSAND and 00/100 (\$14,000.00) DOLLARS for its violations of LAC 42:XI.2405(A)(13) and LAC 42:XI.2417(B)(4).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of FOURTEEN THOUSAND and 60/100 (\$14,000.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Licensee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Licensee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory,

but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remail d the matter to the Heating Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

If approved, Licensez agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within tiffeen (15) days of approval of this settl ment by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. I teensee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of the gaming beense without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
