

JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF STIPULATIONS AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

ON THE JOINT MOTION OF:

- 1. The Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police, Video Gaming Division ("Division"), and
- 2. Carville Entertainment d/b/a Carville's Deli, ("Carville"), who respectfully represent the following:

WHEREAS:

- 1. Carville failed to provide prepared foods for on-premise or immediate consumption during hours open to the public meanwhile allowing patrons access to video gaming machines.
- 2. Carville failed to have a designated representative present and available within the licensed establishment during hours of operation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Stipulations, the Division and Carville hereby propose the following settlement:

1. Carville admits that it was in violation of La. R.S. 27:301(B) (12)(b) and LAC 42:XI.2407(A)(8).

- 2. In lieu of five days suspension, Carville agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of One thousand seven hundred eighty-five dollars and seventy cents (\$1785.70) equal to five days revenue.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this violation in connection with any future violation.
- 4. The form and substance of this settlement are to be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This settlement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Carville pertaining to the subject matter contained herein, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations, and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This settlement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer of the Louisiana Gaming Control Board; it is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not executory and will be submitted to the Board for its determination as to whether the matter should be heard by the Hearing Officer; if approved, however, payment of the above penalty must be submitted to the Division within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board.
- 7. The failure of Carville to submit payment within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Board shall constitute an additional violation of Louisiana gaming laws and regulations.
- 8. The Division and Carville waive their rights to appeal this settlement if the Order is signed by the Hearing Officer and accepted by the Board.
