COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State Police (hereinafter "the Division") and Great American Base Company (hereinafter "the Permittee), a Non-Gaming Supplier, Permittee No. P086502680, do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Great American Base Company which notice alleges certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action are set for hearing on May 28, 2008, before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing Office; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all disputes and issues raised in connection with the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- On December 4, 2007, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to Great American Base Company alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
- Great American Base Company admits it did not timely submit photographs and an occupational license, thereby violating the administrative rules cited in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Great American Base Company agrees to pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted stipulations and violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future determination of the suitability of Great American Base Company.
- 4. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and Great American Base Company pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the

Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that

if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not

thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its

determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing

Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

6 If approved, Great American Base Company must make payment of the

civil penalty and delinquency fee to the Division within ten (10) days of approval by the

Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Failure to do so shall result in the immediate

suspension of the Permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until

such time as the penalty is paid in full.

The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be 7

interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.

I have read this entire Compromise Settlement Agreement, understand it, and agree to all

Stipulations, Terms and Conditions hereof.
