COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Louisiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Division (hereinafter, the "Division") and Sun Coast Resources, LLC (hereinafter, the "Permittee"), do hereby represent and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has sent a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Permittee, which Notice contains allegations of certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Permittee are desirous of fully and finally compromising and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with said Notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- The Permittee is a Non-Gaming Supplier located at 6405 Cavalcade St., Building
 Houston, Texas, 77026.
- 2. On March 7, 2023, the Division received the Permittee's completed Annual Permit Update Form, which indicated no change within the structure of the permittee.

- 3. On March 10, 2023, the Permittee changed its name from Sun Coast Resources, Inc. to Sun Coast Resources, LLC but failed to notify the Division of this change.
- 4. The Division became aware of this conversion through electronic communications with the Permittee on September 21, 2023.
- 5. The Permittee failed to timely notify the Division of its conversion within fifteen (15) days of the conversion, as required by law, in violation of LAC 42:III.2901(B)(4)(b) and (c).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. In lieu of administrative action, Permittee will pay a penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS for its violation of LAC 42:III.2901(B)(4)(b) and (c).
- 2. The Division hereby agrees that payment of a total penalty of FIVE HUNDRED and 00/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS shall be in full and final settlement of all matters set forth in the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration this admitted violation in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty and in connection with any future assessments of Permittee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Permittee, pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.

6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.

7. If approved, Permittee agrees to make full payment of the civil penalty within fifteen (15) days of approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. Permittee agrees that failure to meet this requirement shall result in immediate suspension of its gaming permit without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
