COMPROMISE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The State of Louisiana, Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of State

Police (hereinafter, the "Division") and EHM, LTD. d/b/a Mr. Sam's Deli and Chicken Café

(hereinafter, "EHM" or "Licensee"), License No. 2600212475, do hereby represent and agree as

follows:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board has issued a Notice of

Recommendation of Administrative Action, alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming

Control Law; and

WHEREAS, the issues raised by the said Notice of Recommendation of Administrative

Action are set for hearing before the Louisiana Gaming Control Board Administrative Hearing

Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Division and Licensee are desirous of fully and finally compromising

and settling all issues and disputes arising out of and in connection with the said Notice of

Recommendation of Administrative Action; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto do hereby

agree and stipulate as follows:

STIPULATIONS

- 1. By correspondence dated July 3, 2007, the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") notified the Division that EHM and Songkram Rodchuer were delinquent in the filing and/or paying of taxes owed to the IRS.
- 2. On August 18, 2007, the Division prepared and mailed, via certified mail, a thirty (30) day compliance letter regarding the tax delinquency to EHM's business address, 3531 Jefferson Highway, Jefferson, Louisiana 70121 and to Songkram Rodchuer's residential address, 2026 Hempstead Street, Slidell, Louisiana 70461. The Licensee had thirty (30) days to contact an agent for the IRS to settle the delinquency.
- 3. On December 10, 2007, the Division issued a Notice of Availability of Compliance Conference to the Licensee. The Compliance Conference was scheduled for January 10, 2008. No representative for the Licensee appeared for the conference.
- 4. On January 21, 2008, the Louisiana Gaming Control Board issued a Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action to the Licensee alleging certain violations of Louisiana Gaming Control Law.
- 5. On February 21, 2008, the IRS informed the Division that the Licensee and Songkram Rodchuer were current in the filing and payment of federal taxes.
- 6. The Licensee does admit it violated LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Within fifteen (15) days of the approval of this settlement by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee shall pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for two violations of LAC 42:XI.2405(B)(1)(b) and LAC 42:XI.2417(C)(1)(i).

- 2. The Division hereby agrees to accept the payment of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in full and final settlement of the Notice of Recommendation of Administrative Action.
- 3. The Division reserves the right to take into consideration these admitted violations in connection with any future investigation, violation or assessment of penalty, and in connection with any future assessments of the Licensee's suitability.
- 4. The terms of this Compromise and Settlement Agreement shall be interpreted under the laws of the State of Louisiana.
- 5. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Division and the Licensee pertaining to the subject matter contained herein and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, representations and understandings of the parties.
- 6. This Compromise and Settlement Agreement is subject to approval by the Hearing Officer and the Louisiana Gaming Control Board. It is expressly understood that if this proposed settlement is approved by the Hearing Officer, this agreement is not thereby executory, but will be submitted to the Louisiana Gaming Control Board for its determination as to whether to approve same or to remand the matter to the Hearing Officer for a full hearing on the merits.
- 7. If approved by the Louisiana Gaming Control Board, the Licensee must pay Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) within fifteen (15) calendar days of such approval. Any failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the gaming license without the necessity of any further administrative action until such time as the penalty is paid in full.

I have read this entire Compromise and Settlement Agreement and agree to all stipulations and terms and conditions hereof.
